

SQA National Courses: Highers and National 5

Full time – Selection Process

When you apply:

You will receive an automated email confirming that we have received your application and will be in contact as per the following stages:

- Initial selection for interview will be based on the information supplied in the application form, in particular the qualifications already gained or pending and your personal statement.
- Further selection will then be by a group information session, attendance at this is mandatory. You should be prepared to make your subject choices at this session.
- Following the group information session we will then check your qualifications in relation to your subject choices and you will receive one of the following:
 - An unconditional offer
 - A conditional offer (based on results pending). Please note it is your responsibility to ensure you notify us if you have met your conditions within 5 days of SQA results being published.
 - An invitation to interview
 - A rejection
- Note that the majority of interviews take place between mid-May and June
- The results of interviews will be notified within 10 working days of the interview.

Once an offer is received you must reply within 10 working days or risk losing your place.

If a place is unavailable at your campus of first choice, you may be offered a place at one of our other campuses and you must respond to this within the timescale above.

Once you have accepted your offer, you will be sent further information e.g. Student Funding, Joining Instructions, Kit List and Induction Date.
