1. Report Purpose

This paper provides members with a formal oversight of the governance procedures applied internally prior to the student elections.

3. Background

The Henderson Loggie Internal Audit on Corporate Governance stated:

"We consider there would be benefit in more formal procedures about the student nomination and election to be created, including what oversight should by undertaken by College management, and that there should be reporting by College management to the Board, both before (about the arrangements in place for the conduct of student elections and nominations) and afterwards (about how the student elections actually progressed and any issues and how these were resolved)".

This report is the first instance of the College management providing formal reports prior to, and after the student election in each session.

Attached are extracts from the GCCSA Constitution (17.101A), GCCSA Schedules (17.101B), 2017 Election Report (17.101C) and a draft Election Timeline (17.101D).
