Application should be made to the Students Awards Agency for Scotland (SAAS) at www.saas.gov.uk

You must apply for your Fees to be paid and there is the option for either a Young Students' Bursary (YSB) or Independent Students' Bursary and student loan for living costs

Tuition Fees

- Must meet Residency requirements
- Must apply to SAAS who will pay the fees direct to the College on your behalf

- Means Tested on Household Income
- Maximum Award: £7,650
- Minimum Loan: £4,750
- **Student Loan is Repayable**

Evidence Required

- **Household Income**

Applying for Bursary and/or maximum loan: You must send proof of parent's/partner's earnings such as P60s etc

- **Proof of separation/divorce**

If you or your parents are divorced/separated you must send a solicitor's letter or divorce decree

- **Lone Parent Grant (required every year)**

Send proof of lone parent status i.e. tax credit letter, council tax.
Also require full birth certificate of dependent child.

- **Independent Student**

To be assessed on partner's income you submit evidence of living with your partner before the start of the Academic Year i.e. joint mortgage/tenancy agreement
