3	GCC Integrated Grants Fund and Area Committee Input	Louise Dobbie from Democratic Services was invited to speak to the partnership in relation to the area grants and integrated grants funds. Cannot be used for small pilot projects (12 weeks limit). Forms will be circulated electronically by Louise. Some members asked about who their grant officer is. Louise advised contact details are on the guidance notes. Louise advised that projects can apply for "additional funding" for materials and resources. <b>Integrated Grants fund</b> update was given. Potentially funding will be for 3 years. This year there are a number of programmes. Fairer Communities, Sustainable Communities, Safer Communities, Youth

Applicants choose the most appropriate programmes and pick outcomes etc. A lengthy discussion around the bid the Partnership would like to submit took place.
