INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES STANDING IN THE GCCSA ELECTION FOR 2020

Who can run?

Any student currently matriculated at Glasgow Clyde College in the UK and actively pursuing their studies towards a qualification (as confirmed by Glasgow Clyde College), is eligible to stand for office for either the President or Vice President roles.

Please note that the President role is a full time role and is therefore suitable for a student at the end of their studies at Glasgow Clyde College who can commit to the full time position. This is also suitable for a student who chooses to take a gap year from their studies to take up the positon for a year before returning to their studies or heading on to another opportunity. The main thing to note is that it is full time hours.

The Vice President roles are part time and are therefore suitable for students who are currently studying at Glasgow Clyde College but can commit to this part time position.

NOTE: Any individual student can only run for one position. In addition, students can only submit one nomination per role. This means that a student can propose or second a single person for the role of President. They cannot propose one person and second another. This is the same for the role of Vice- President also.

Status Check

All elected officers will be subject to status checks through Disclosure Scotland or another appropriate organisation to ensure that they are eligible.

Successful candidates may be asked to provide a reference from their guidance tutor.

Wages and working hours can be found in the job description, which GCCSA can provide.

As these are paid positions, you must have the legal right to work within the UK over the full term in office. August 5^{3h} to June 11th of the respective years.
