



## What is period inequality?

1 in 10 people who flow in the UK will experience period poverty at some point in their lives.

Putting it simply, period poverty refers to the lack of access to period products.

Period poverty is more common and complex than we might think. It can also be linked to wider systematic inequalities, lack of education or understanding about periods, period stigma, a lack of access to other hygiene products or a lack of access to safe spaces to change products.

Everyone who flows in UK educational institutions is eligible to FREE period products.

You have the right to take home as many period products as you wish and should provide any feedback you may have regarding the type of products or placement of products to your institution.
