

Information for ESOL applications

When you complete an application to apply to study ESOL at Glasgow Clyde College, we will ask:

- Personal information (name, address, phone number, email)
- Your ESOL level (if you know this)
- Do you have Additional support needs?
- Your residency status (are you a UK national / refugee / Asylum Seeker / Leave to Remain / etc)
- Your nationality
- How long have you lived in the UK?

You will also be asked if you require any **support to help you study**.

If you would like to disclose any disability or long-term condition, support is available from the college [Learning Inclusion team](#). Your answers are treated confidentially and will be shared with our Learning Support team who will contact you to discuss support needs (if you have a place in a class).

You will also be asked about whether you are **care experienced, or have responsibilities as a young carer**.

Your answers are treated confidentially and will be shared with our [Student Advice Team](#) who will provide a named advisor for you to contact for support.
